What We Will Learn	This unit of work pupils will discover all about themselves, their likes, dislikes and their interests and their personality. What We Will Do	Pupils will be able to discuss things they like and things they don't like. They will be able to say what they are good at and discuss themselves and interests, through whole class discussions and group work.	Pupils will discuss money and its importance. They will work as part of a team and share their ideas to plan a Christmas project. They will produce an item to sell, they will have to agree and vote on the best product to make for their Christmas sale.	Pupils will discuss the different job choices in our local area. They will be introduced to a range of job opportunities from all over the UK. They will also touch on how jobs have changed over time, related to local area such as coal mining ship yards etc...	Pupils will discuss their own skills that they already have and skills that they might need in the future. They will talk about taking responsibility for themselves. They will be able to discuss their basic human rights and identify who to go to if they have a problem.	Pupils will be encouraged to think about how they travel to and from somewhere. They will discuss the different modes of transport. They will be able to tell a friend about how they would reach a destination using the correct mode of transport. For example how would they travel to the local shops or how would they travel to London or France?
