What We Will Learn	This 'Autumn' themed unit pupils will learn how to use pencil, colour, paint, print, collage and paper to create quality art work that shows progression in skills. The children will also have the opportunity to explore the work of several paintings of Autumn scenes, also works by Matisse and by Cezanne.	Pupils will learn all about 'European Art' and look at the different styles of art works. The children will also have the opportunity to explore the work of European artists Anselm Kiefer, Michelangelo, Salvador Dali and Rembrandt, architect Le Corbusier and designer Coco Chanel.	Pupils will learn how to use a range of media for making portraits, they will also have the opportunity to explore the work of British artists Thomas Gainsborough, Lucian Freud, Howard Hodgkin, Anish Kapoor, Paula Rego and Sonia Boyce.
What We Will Do	Pupils will shape or sculpt paper to resemble leaves. They will name some of Matisse's paintings and give facts about his life and work. The will discuss and name some of Cezanne's paintings. They will have the opportunity to look at a range of 'other' 'Autumn' painters and discuss their likes/dislikes. They will be able to mix appropriate colours for their work.	Pupils will look at a range of photos of building that need repaired or broken, they will paint on the ceiling like Michelangelo and discuss the difficulties about this. They will create abstract 'cut ups' and make shape houses in the style of an artist. They will also draw a portrait using a rubber.	Pupils will draw illustrations and paint with colour, they will make 'sensory' boxes, create abstract 'cut ups', tell stories in pictures and write memory postcards to create quality artwork that shows progression in skills
Skills Learned	Pupils will develop their observation skills paying attention to detail to improve prior skills and techniques learned within art and design.	Pupils will use a wide range of art and design techniques developing their skills in colour, texture, pattern, shape, form and line.	Pupils will further develop their skills and knowledge to learn about great artists, architects and designers in history, they will be able to comment on their 'own' and others' and share their opinion.
